Realignment took from 5A but gave nothing back. With the departure of five schools the field thins out just a bit. Couple that with graduation and you have only 51 of the 112 wrestlers from the 2020 state tournament coming back. So who is the team to beat? The numbers point to J. F. Byrnes High School. They return state champions Chris Compton and David Hunsberger as well as two other placer/qualifiers for a total of 59 points. River Bluff is the only other team to return four with experience from the 2020 state tournament. Coach Howard has been creating quite a solid group in Duncan, SC and if he can reload in the right places he will be poised for another run at the allusive state title the Rebels have been hunting for the past two years.

Contenders

With a new coach in Anthony Esposito and a couple of returning state champs (Thomas Snipes and Eyan McKnight) Hillcrest will continue to be in the way of Byrnes for that title.
